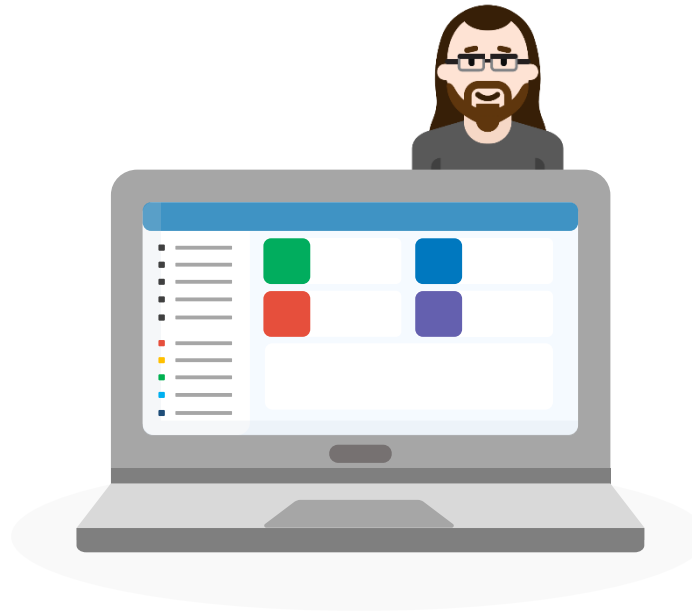

midPoint is part of the
InCommon brand

- > Product bug fixing
- > Development of missing features
(e.g., Flexible Auth, Multi Affiliations)

- > Improvements to midPoint
- > Documentation improvements
- > Product knowledge sharing

Development Driven by our Academic Subscription in Practice – Use Cases

- > Flexible authentication
 - > SAML2
 - > HTTP header (Shibboleth SP integration)
 - > OIDC (in progress)
- > Asynchronous connector
 - > Leveraged experience from the Grouper connector
 - > Developed despite our reservations about messaging

Academic Subscription in Practice – Use Cases

- > Unsupported UUID data type for the DBTable connector
 - > Problem replication & bug confirmation
 - > Workaround + JIRA bug report
- > Unexpected mapping behavior
 - > Sharing the mapping definition and describing the use case
 - > Debugging with tracing for complex cases
 - > Providing solutions and relevant recommendations
- > Bug using tracing feature
 - > A workaround using a custom midPoint build
 - > The workaround used to generate a trace that helped with other issues
 - > The workaround included in upstream

Academic Subscription in Practice – Use Cases

- > Parametric role question
 - > Sharing information about the use cases
 - > Analysis and recommendation
 - > Solved using parametric assignments
- > Use midPoint to detect and link existing accounts
 - > Sharing information about the use cases
 - > Analysis and solution using resource conf. + live sync
 - > The solution was too slow for newly created accounts in midPoint
 - > New solution using policies
