



### **New Support Model**

- Feature releases 2 years of support
  - No possibility for extended support
- LTS releases 5 years of support
  - Possibility for extended support +3 years
  - Possibility for vintage support +2 years
  - => up to 10 years of support
- LTS released every 4th year
  - Next LTS in 2027
- New support model applicable since version 4.8





## MidPoint 4.8 "Curie" at a Glance

#### **Role Mining**

- AI/ML powered functionality for mining roles based on the existing data in midPoint
  - Analyzing existing assignments to application roles
  - Detection based on data clustering, pattern recognition and similarity methods.
  - Suggestion of new business roles candidates
- Bottom-up approach to create business roles
- Helps with simplifying role-based access control
- Reduces risk of access escalation
- Makes entire IGA more understandable and manageable

### **Role Mining - Benefits**

- Simplified access management
  - Assign one business role rather than multiple individual accesses.
- Reduced administrative overhead
  - No need to picking up multiple accesses related to job position or project.
- Transparent access
  - Simplifies compliance reporting.
- Efficient audit trails
  - Capturing more significant, meaningful changes and reducing the noise
- Enhanced business agility






### **Identity Recovery**

- Possibility to recover identity data
- Configuration adjusted according to the type of identity
- Different recovery options available for different types of identities
- Using existing midPoint functionality
  - Smart correlation
  - Flexible authentication
- Disclosure information auditing




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
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### **Flexible Authentication**

- New modules added:
  - Archetype selection module
  - Correlation module
  - DUO module
- Improved OIDC module
- Support for MFA






### **Security-related Improvements**

- Performance improvements
  - GUI,
  - Reports,
  - Scripts using midpoint.getObject(..), midpoint.searchObejcts(..)
- Priviledge elevation
  - runAsRef vs. runPrivileged
  - Improved auditing
- Trusted bulk actions
  - Custom actions executable by non-super users
- OWASP dependency check



### **Streamline Upgrades**


- Ninja
  - A command line tool for low level management of data
- Significantly improved during 4.8
  - Focusing on upgrade procedure
- Verification and objects upgrade
- Pre-upgrade checks
- DB schema upgrade
- Installation upgrade
- Initial objects upgrade (experimental)





### **Firsts Steps Methodology**


- midPoint deployment methodology
  - Describing iterative approach
  - Providing value in small steps asap
- Steps included
  - Connecting source/target system
  - Using smart correlation
  - Testing with simulations
  - Detecting and handling orphaned accounts with marks
  - Managing identity lifecycle
  - Automating the JML processes
  - Managing birthright permissions
  - Go live with any quality of data





#### **Resource Wizard**


- Pre-defined activation mappings
  - Delayed delete
  - Disable instead of delete
  - Pre-create
- Password step
- Better integration with resource details



### **Changes Since midPoint 4.4**

- Simulations
- Object marks
- Smart correlation
- Request access wizard
- Improved IGA reporting
- Resource templates
- Refreshed look&feel





#### **Platforms**

- Operations systems
  - Linux
  - Windows Server 2022
- Java
  - Java 21 recommended
  - Java 17
- Databases
  - PostgreSQL 14, 15, 16 (native implementation)
  - Orace 21c (generic implementation)
  - Miscrosoft SQL Server 2019 (generic implementation)





#### **Deprecations, Removals and Incompatible Changes**

- Support for PostgreSQL with generic repository implementation was removed
  - Migrate to native implementation when using PostgreSQL
- Ninja options were consilidated, which resulted to the incompatible changes
  - See the release notes and documentation
- Password reset with only mailNonce or securityQuestions authentication module won't work. Another module before the those two is required to identify the user.
  - focusidentification module can be used.
- Initial objects changes
  - See the release notes
- Schema deprecations
  - Use ninja to show you the deprecations





### A plan for 4.9

- Planned release date October 1, 2024
  - One-year release cycle
  - Feature release
- Features and Improvements planned
  - WCAG Compliance
  - Attribute caching
  - Lightweight processing
  - Role Engineering improvements
  - Configuration management
  - Certifications improvements
  - Advanced lifecycle model
  - Simplified groups and memberships management


