





Overview

- Give users option to ask for new access
 - Process split into multiple steps
- Improved user interface
- More configuration possibilities
- Configuration can be combined via archetypes
- Plays well with approvals and SoD

Tips & Tricks

- Disable unused options/features
 - Unnecessary steps will be hidden
- Make sure to implement proper autocomplete configuration
 - Persons of interest (groups)
 - Role of team-mate
- Don't use more than 3-4 levels of role hierarchy (UX)



Distant Future

- Request for others than users typically when someone is requesting for the "All people from the team" it should be rather inducement for "team" than a assignment per user
- Possibility to add attachment
- Better configurability to "Role preview details" tile/table configuration and popup to display role details, e.g. approvers, role inducements, etc.
- Small improvements
 - Shopping cart (last step) how do I know which users am I requesting for?
 - Save filters



Conclusion



- Request access wizard UI/UX improved
- Ask for myself or multiple users
- All steps fully configurable
- Checks for conflicts
